SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The purpose of the Traffic Club of Memphis Educational Foundation Scholarship Program is to promote the continuation of professionalism in the traffic, transportation and/or logistical field by annually awarding at least one scholarship of up to \$3,500 to a college student pursuing higher education in this area of study according to the following guidelines:

1- A scholarship or (s) of up to \$3,500.00 will be awarded using the following selection criteria:

1-Applicant is entering their **junior, senior or post-graduate year as a full-time student** and enrolled in a degree program in traffic, transportation, supply chain management or logistical field.

2-Applicant is entering their **junior, senior or post-graduate year as a part-time student** and enrolled in a degree program in traffic, transportation, supply chain management or logistical field.

2- Scholarship will be for tuition and/or books with payment made directly to the school.

3- Scholarship will be for the school term beginning with the fall term and can be used through the following summer term.

4- Scholarship will be considered secondary to any other received scholarship or (s) and/or any company reimbursement program.

5- Applicant may attend any higher learning institution.

6- Applicant must submit their application by June 30th with presentation made by The Traffic Club of Memphis Educational Foundation by August 15th.

7- The selection(s) will be made by the Scholarship Board Director, President and one other Board Director (preferably a past Scholarship Board Director)

8- Publicity of the Scholarship Program will be through the club newsletter, meeting announcements, TCOM's phone hotline, web page and other means available by the Club.

9- A transcript or a copy of the applicant's most recent report card must be submitted along with the scholarship application to be considered for a scholarship.
